SERVICE PROJECTS:

White Hills:

Corby relayed the approximately 12-mile loop on Trailsfork app to Mark Farmer of DWR which we proposed maintaining in partnership with the State. Corby called to follow up. Mr. Farmer indicated he received the file. He is not able to meet with us this fall at White Hills, but asked if we could attend the winter meeting with DWR. We discussed some of the possible elements of a service project:

- Gate installed on the north.
- Gate replaced in parking area. (DWR would supply it; we'd install it.) Corby knows some people with an auger and a backhoe to assist in this.
- Signage (we'd pay for and install)
- Map with a steel post. It could say "sponsored by Central Utah BCH."
- Tie rails in big parking area.

Canal Canyon

We have been gathering information on specific erosion on trails in Canal Canyon to present to the Forest Service. A meeting will be set up before the next meeting.

Following are possible projects to present.

- Tie rails for horse parking only
- Parking lot enlarged
- Road made wider by fixing runoff ditch
- Oak brush trimmed.
- Toilet
- Trail erosion addressed.
