1. WHITE HILLS PROJECT:



Thirty loads of road base has been delivered. Next week it will be spread by the State. Cost is about \$12,000. Because it was decided not to use gravel there will be money to put toward signs. It was proposed to have a company in Texas (Izone) do the signs. A 38 x 35 sign costs about \$550. These are all weather quality signs that are made to last.

Steve and Tom both have drill pipe that can be used for tie rails. These will be put in June 9; work party start time is 8:30 AM. Anyone who can help would be appreciated. Kiosk for this location will also be worked on.

We discussed maybe using railroad ties to make mounting blocks.

2. CANAL CANYON PROJECTS:

Clearing brush and logs from trails.

This fall FS is hoping to start enlarging the parking lot. We will be putting up a fence at the start of the trail. Anyone interested Lynn has a map of what it proposed to be done.
