1. WHITE HILLS PROJECT:



Corby arranged a meeting with Mark Farmer, State Division of Wildlife, for 9/20 regarding White Hills signage. We have left in the \$30K grant \$20,172.20 after Stephen Strate bills the City for his tractor work at White Hills. (His projected amount is included in this total.)

So far we have contributed 335 hours of labor to this project.

Subsequently, on 9/20, we had a meeting with Mark Farmer and marked trails on his master map still in use, determined bike and horse trails as well as horse only trails. We chose names for these trails so we could proceed with the signage. The rules of who can use what when were discussed, and will be marked on the kiosks and also the signs.

3. EPHRAIM CANYON TRAILS
