

An in-person meeting was held Tuesday, 1/10/2023 at 7 p.m. for the Central Utah BCH at the Mt. Pleasant Vet Clinic Offices in Mt. Pleasant. Lynn is going to look into holding meetings here each month rather than Contoy Great Room.

1. **OFFICER ELECTIONS:** The 2022 officers offered to continue into 2023 unless there is someone who wants to have the office this year. President – Lynn Barton; VP – Corby Briggs; Secretary – Joyce Smith; Treasurer – Unknown as Sheila Parker was not present; Patti Fleming – Educational Coordinator. Gifts of Joe Gee’s hobbles were given by the club to the President and VP (Lynn and Corby) for their outstanding service. Sheila will get a backpacking stove.
2. **STATE MEETING:** Julie Heavirland is going to the State meeting in Richfield on 1/21/23. She’ll take a brief presentation of our 2022 accomplishments (attached).
3. **GRANT FOR TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS:** Corby attended another meeting with Mark Farmer and Lara Kendall who was representing bike trails in White Hills. Some modifications were made to the kiosk maps with horse/hiking trails parallel to bike trails. E-bikes are not allowed between Dec 1 – May 1. From May 2 – Nov 30, E-bikes and other motorized vehicles are ONLY allowed on roads. DWR is asking our Central Utah BCH to politely educate people about the rules. We have postponed the leveling of the White Hills parking lot due to the weather. Mark Farmer indicated the signage which we’ve offered to buy marking the trails and names of trails will cost about \$4500-\$5000. This leaves us approximately \$5000 to \$5500 left in the grant. A subsequent conversation with Monte Bona gave us permission to extend spending our grant to September 2023. We were asked to donate to the enlargement of the Canal Canyon trailhead parking lot which Kevin Christensen with Sanpete Tourism is funding. A NEPA document is in the works for it and should be completed this year. Lynn suggested we look at other grants for improving parking in Maple Canyon and other FS projects in the future.
