

An in-person meeting was held Tuesday, 5/2//2023 at 7 p.m. for the Central Utah BCH at then Contoy Great Room in Mt. Pleasant.

1. SERVICE PROJECTS:

- **Canal Canyon** April April 27, 9 am to 3 pm at trailhead work project with Sanpete County and Myron Jeffs Rec Director from Ferron of the Forest Service, phone 435-636-3584 (Rec Director of FS from Ferron). We had 6 people on chainsaws and feeding the chipper for 5 ½ hours. These work hours were recorded with the State. We will be posting some pictures on our FB page. The parking lot will be about the size of the White Hills parking lot we improved which will greatly enhance accessibility to the trails. Joyce will contact Myron Jeffs to see if we could contribute signage for the parking lot after we've determined how much is left in the grant after we pay for the pruner and signage at White Hills (it should be approx.. \$3000).
- Our **Scavenger Hunt** ride and planning for the 4H's was held April 29th @ 10 a.m. in White Hills. The 5-11 year olds will have a paper list and a 2 mile loop to gather several items w/parents and Corby leading. The 12-18 year olds will have three Geocache stations, and using the app Coordinates will find the stations and take pix of each other in unusual hats. Graciella, Patti, Joyce, Julie and Sheila will supply the hats. We need two more riders to take the hats to one of the GPS locations prior to the hunt. We are furnishing hotdogs to grill, water, chips, and cookies. The grand prize winner for the older kids will be determined by a last man standing drawing (draw names until last one is winner) from all participants. The younger kids will win the grand prize by collecting the most items on the list and be back by 7 pm. All kids will receive smaller prizes. All are on horseback, and parents required for ages 5-11.
- We will be having a work party for putting 31 posts for signs in White Hills on Saturday, May 13, at 8:00. Lynn has received the map from Mark Farmer of where to place the signs and what stickers to put on the signs. Lynn also has a quote for the placards and has the stickers for the placards. It's noteworthy **THERE ARE NO "BIKE ONLY" TRAILS** designated by Mark Farmer on the map. Laura Kendall representing the bike community offered to help place posts and will be invited to the work party on May 13th only. We will not be planting any of the poles at this work party, nor installing the placards or stickers. Sheila suggested putting sprinkler flags at the exact locations. Bikes were granted access to White Hills at the April 13th meeting with the State.

2. OTHER DISCUSSION

- Diane and Steve Cote have been trying to order a battery-operated pruner which has been backordered for a long time and is apparently not available anywhere. They were not at the meeting, but asked if a gas powered pruner was acceptable. The consensus was to get a non-powered collapsible pruner based

on the jobs we will need it for. Julie recommended a 20" Silky Catana which is \$350 and is the one used by the Forest Service.
