Basic Exam provides important information for your veterinarian:

1. Temperature (normal 99.5 to 101.5)
2. Heart rate (normal 28-44 beats per minutes)
3. Respiratory rate (normal rate 12 – 16 breaths per minute)
4. Gut sounds (you should hear some sounds, not silence, but not too much sound)
5. Mucous membrane color
6. Capillary refill time
7. Attitude and appetite
