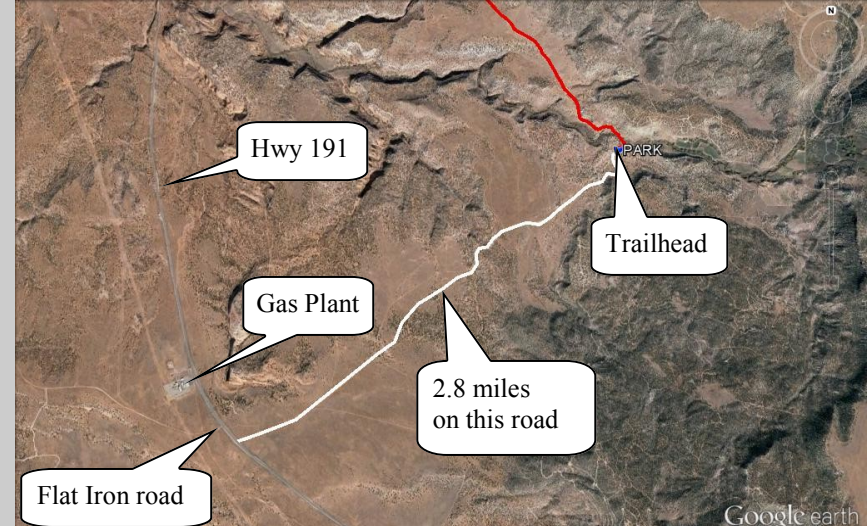
The ride goes North and loops around Mule Shoe Canyon. The canyon is impressive! You will encounter several areas of slickrock. The views to the North and West are wonderful.

This ride is an “Out & Back”.

Extra Riding

There is a junction at the beginning of the ride that goes East to La Sal. Its an old 4x4 road.

There are some private homes along the route. You can go East all the way to South Mountain.



Directions to Trailhead

Trailhead Parking

From the South Side Shell Gas go 16.2 miles South on Hwy 191 to the Gas Plant. Flat Iron Mesa road is on right .3 miles pas the Gas Plant. You make a Left turn .1 miles past the Flat Iron road. Follow the dirt road for 2.8 miles. You will come to an old fenced corral. This is the trailhead.

Brown’s Hole Trail Map

Follow 4x4 road to start with.
Cross several areas of Slickrock.
The trail loops around Mule Shoe Cyn.
