

Ride #098

The "Fisher Tower" ride is an easy 6.5 mile ride.

The ride starts off in Onion Creek.

After a short distance you head Easterly over past the Fisher Tower road.

Cross the road and head towards the Towers.

Loop around and head back.

There are some deep gullies to avoid.

A beautiful ride especially during the spring and fall.

Summer is hot with little protection.

WARNING: Beware of flash floods.

Know the weather if you ride the creek.

Extra Riding

You can also ride Onion Creek up into the mountains. Onion Creek trail is a nice 10 mile loop to the West. Also Mary Jane Canyon and Sylvester are 4 miles West. You can cross Hwy 128 and find some Colorado River trails.

Fisher Towers Trail Map

6.5 mile loop to a U-turn.
Start in Onion Creek bed
Then East and cross Fisher Tower road.
You can meander around the hills and gullies until you decide to return.
Watch out for the deep gullies.



Directions to Trailhead

Trailhead Parking

Take Hwy 191 about 3 miles North from Moab.

Directions to the trailhead starts at Jct Hwy 191 & Hwy 128

Go East on Hwy 128 about 20 miles,

Look for Onion Creek Campground

Turn right off of Hwy 128 and go about 1 mile

Here there is a Kieosk on your left, Campsite has a large loop
