This ride is part of the "Old Spanish Trail"

There are some old trail/tracks to follow

But the trail West is mostly winging it.

There are gullies and hills to traverse

as you find your way West to


Horse Canyon road. Follow Horse Canyon road

South for 1 mile before heading back.

The return starts at an old 4x4 trail that heads East.

Extra Riding

There are several dirt roads in the area to follow
They go up into the Book Cliffs area
Also, when you intersect Horse Canyon road
you can ride North many miles.
You can also continue West from Horse Canyon road
and ride to the city of Green River



Directions to Trailhead



The trail is basically unmarked. Some guess work is involved. There are many gullies and large mounds that have to be ridden around, thru or over.

Trailhead Parking

Dirrections start at Hwy 191 & 313
Go North on Hwy 191 to I-70
Take I-70 West to Exit #175 (Floy)Road)
Go Right & West on Old Hwy 6 & 50 .3 miles
Turn Right on Floy Roar (a dirt road)
Follow Floy Rd 3.3 miles to a Jct,
Turn left, go .2 miles .
The old sheep camp here is the trailhead
