Some of the ride is cross-country and
some is on old seismic roads.


Professor Valley is basically "open riding".
Nice views of Colorado River.

A beautiful ride especially during the spring and fall.
Summer is hot with little protection.

WARNING: Beware of flash floods. These dry creek beds can be dangerous.

Extra Riding

You can also ride East to Onion Creek, Onion Creek trail is a nice 10 mile loop. Also Mary Jane Canyon and Sylvester are 2 miles S-W. Sterns Slot Canyon is 2 miles West or Parking.



Directions to Trailhead

Professor Valley Trail Map

7.25 mile loop back to parking.
The first portion is cross-country.
Then you catch an old seismic road.
This loops around and then heads East.
You then catch a dry wash back to
the parking area.

Trailhead Parking

Take Hwy 191 about 3 miles North of Moab.

Directions to the trailhead starts at Jct Hwy 191 & Hwy 128

Go East on Hwy 128 about 19.2 miles,

Look for a small sign saying "CFI"

The "CFI" turn-off is .9 miles past Professor Valley road.

Turn right off of Hwy 128 and go about .5 mile

There will be a large parking on your left.
