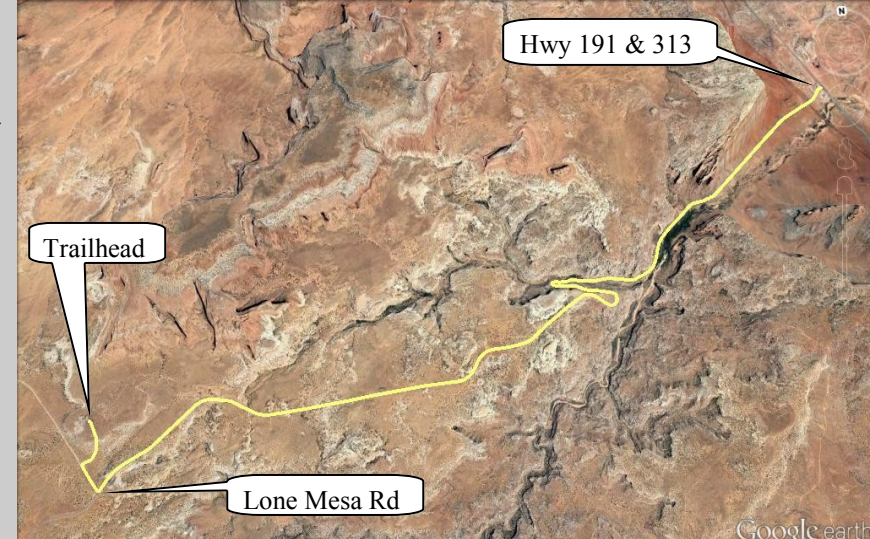


Cliff Return

 The ride heads North-East from Hwy 313
 It is a beautiful ride especially during the spring and fall.
 Summer can be hot, not any protection.
 The views on this ride are of the
 red rocks & La Sal Mountains.
 Some slick rock, but mostly sandy 4x4 roads.
 You will encounter some off-road vehicles on this ride.

 as well as the South side of Hwy 313.
 The Endurance Camp Trailhead is about 3 miles
 West of the Lone Mesa Campgrounds.
 Lots of riding in this area.

Trailhead Parking
 Directions to the trailhead starts at Jet Hwy 191 & Hwy 313
 Go West on Hwy 313 about 8.5 miles,
 Look for Lone Mesa sign on the right
 After you turn off of Hwy 313 you will
 go 1/4 mile and turn right
 The Trailhead is a 1/4 mile in on the
 Lone Mesa Campground road
